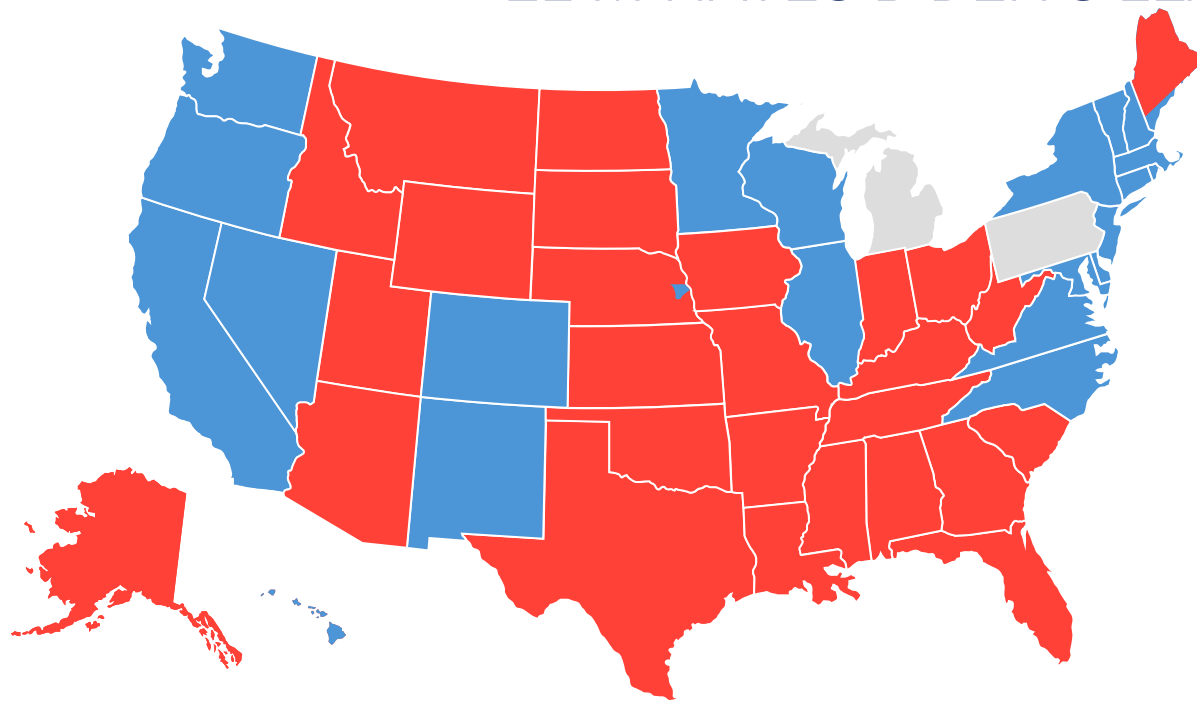

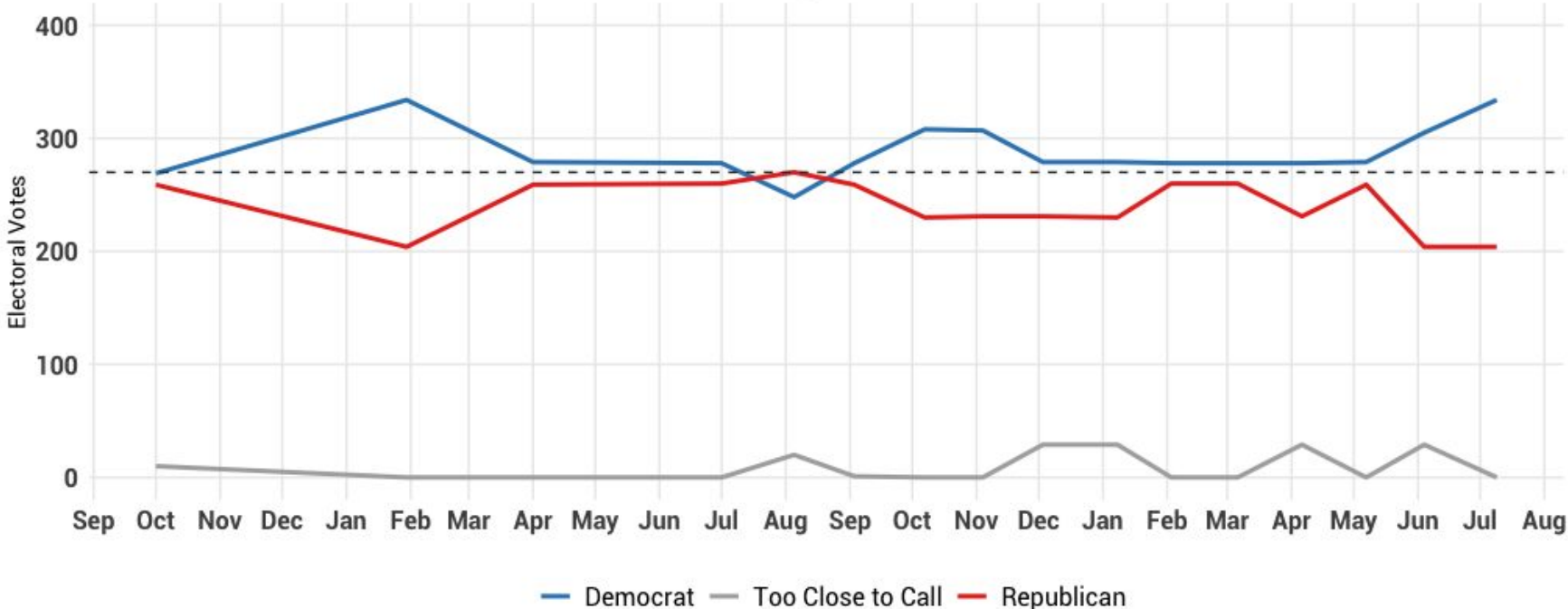

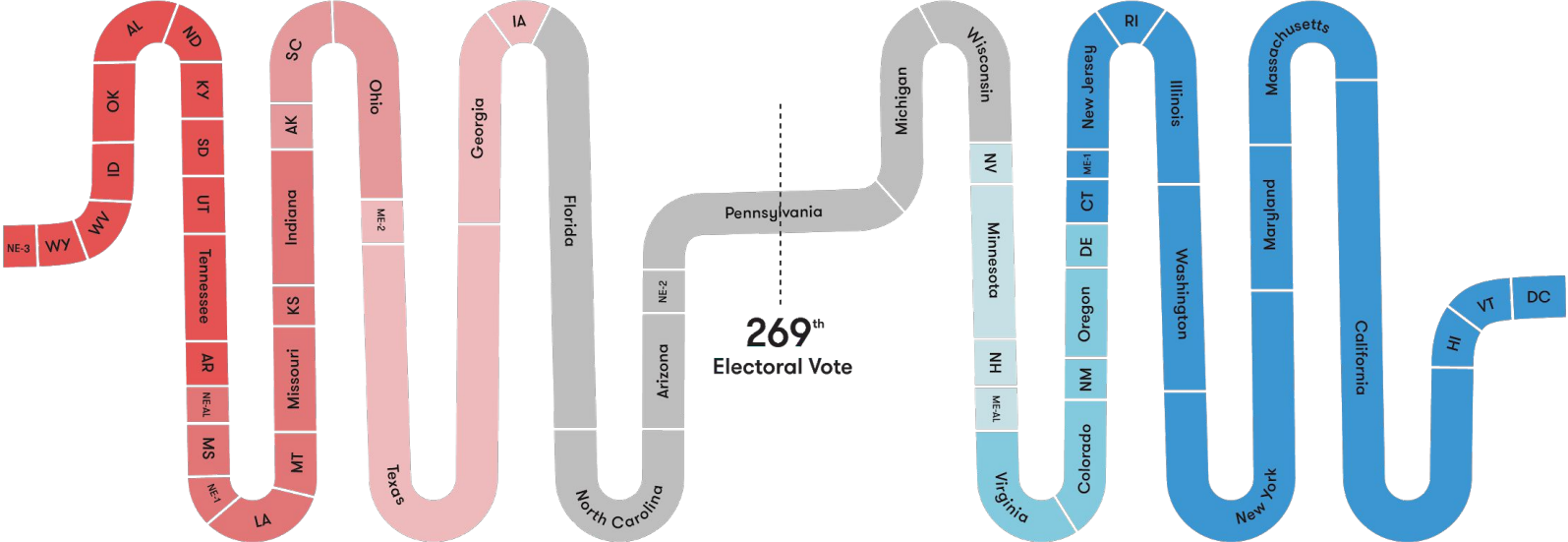


FAVORABLE POLLS AND RISING DJT JOB DISAPPROVAL INCREASED TOPLINE

POSITIVE MOVEMENT IN AZ, NC OPEN NEW PATHS TO 270

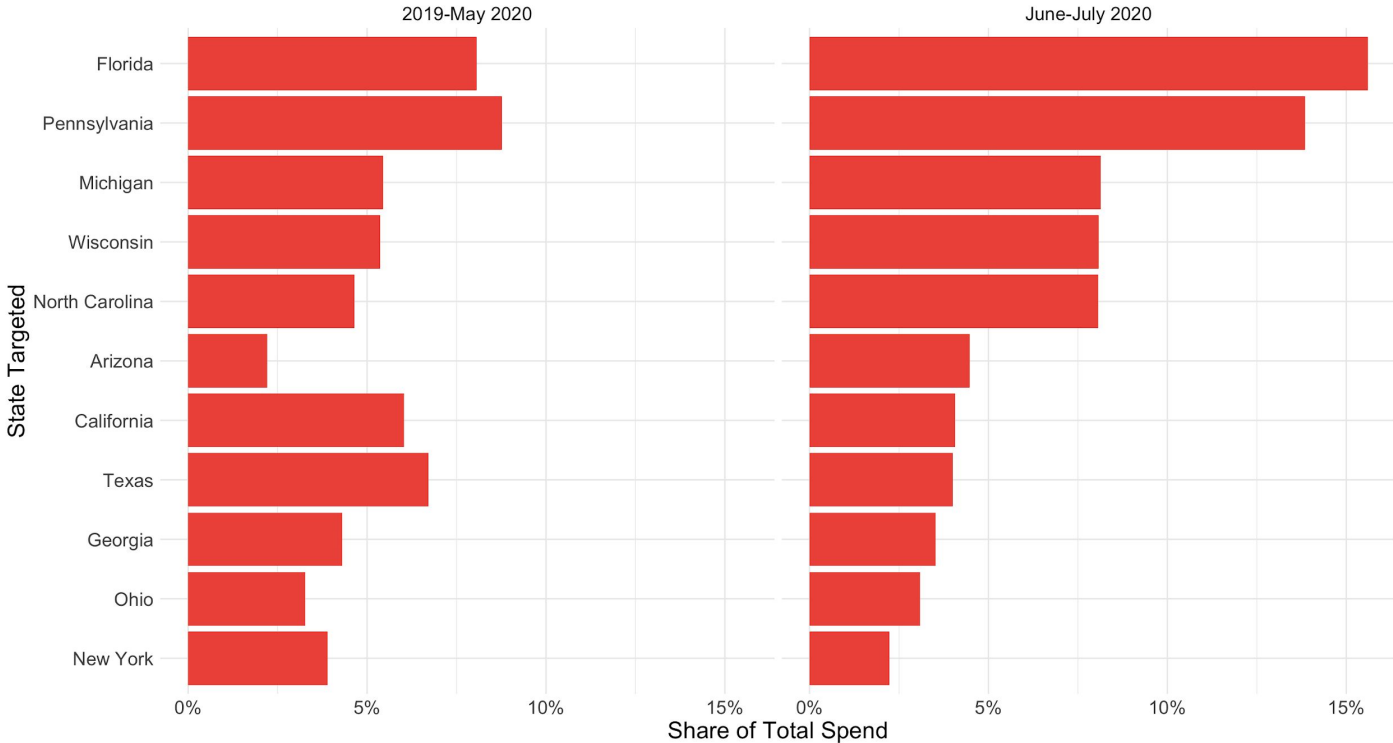

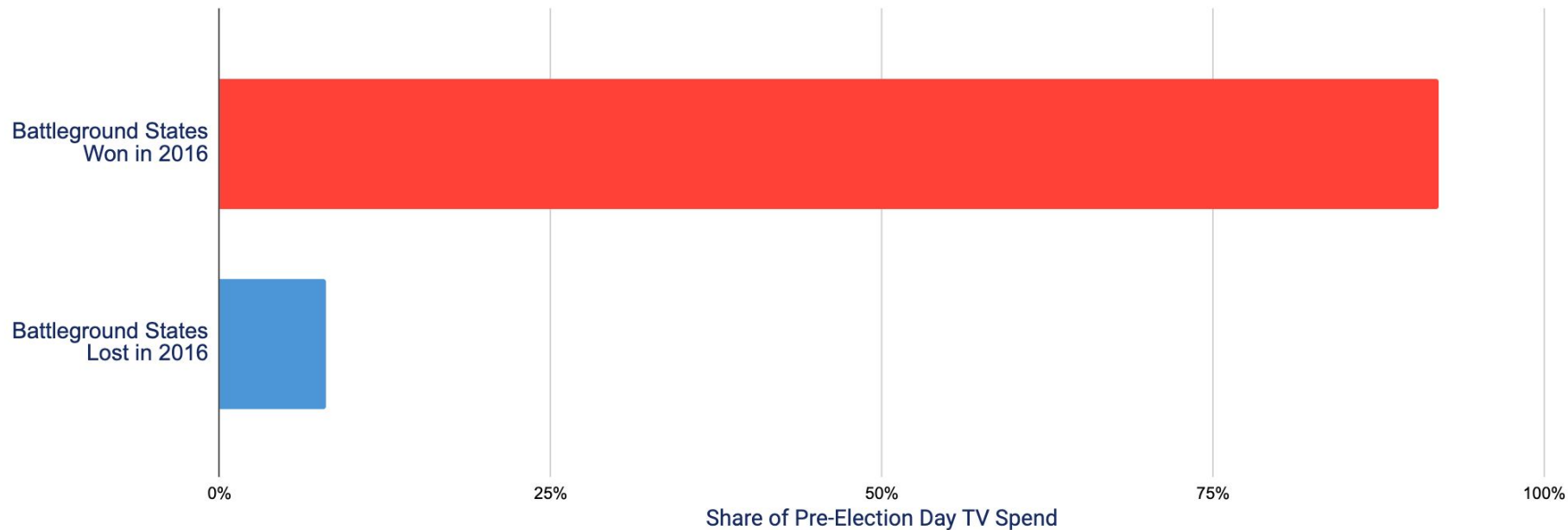

TRUMP'S TV SPENDING IS LARGELY FOCUSED ON STATES HE WON IN 2016

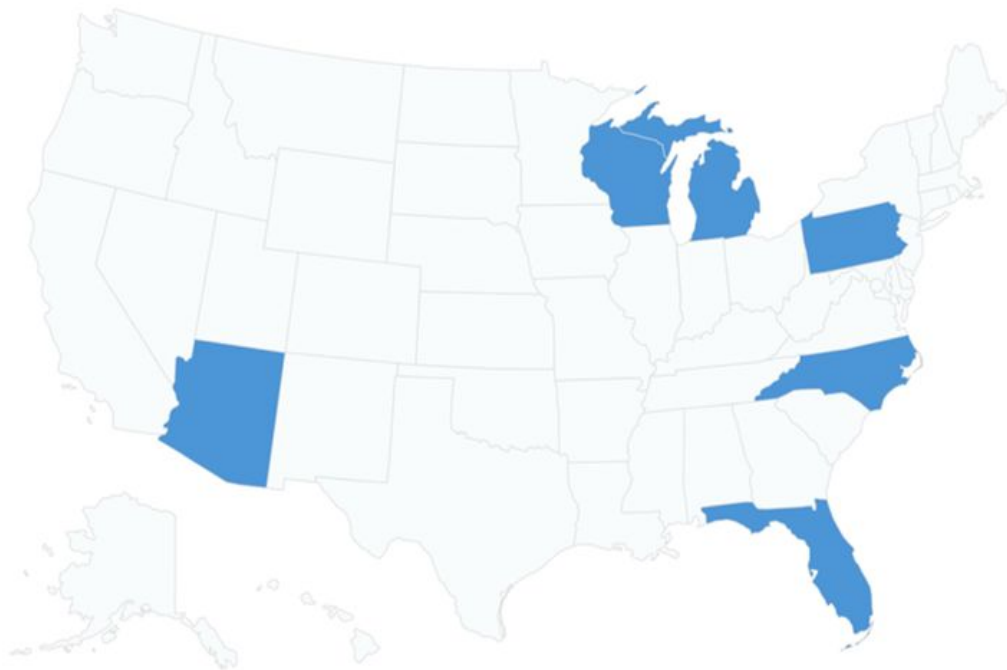


NEW BATTLEGROUND POLLING

Methodology

PHONE SURVEYS: LIKELY VOTERS

- 4,805 likely voters across six key battleground states: Arizona, Florida, Michigan, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin (800 interviews per state).
- Conducted June 24th to July 1st, 2020.
- Among those who voted in 2016: 46% Clinton, 47% Trump, 4% third-party candidate (self-report).
- Results weighted in proportion to share of electoral votes per state. Within states, results weighted to demographics of a likely presidential electorate.



Trump is in dangerous territory with voters as his leadership failures on coronavirus continue to drag him down.

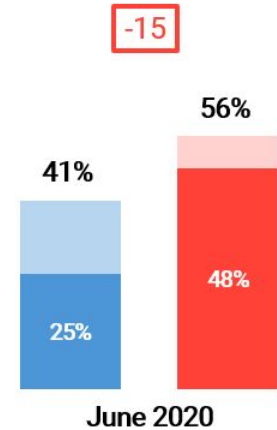
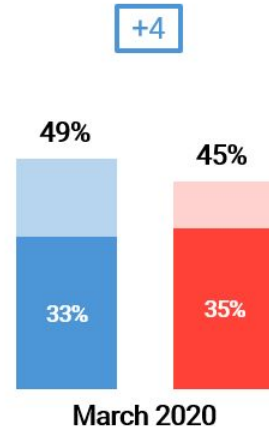
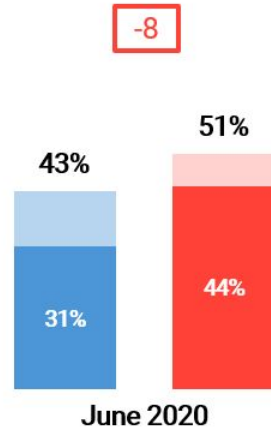
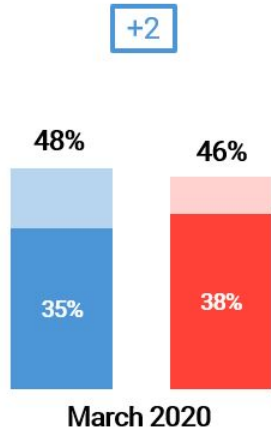

■ Strongly disapprove ■ Just somewhat disapprove

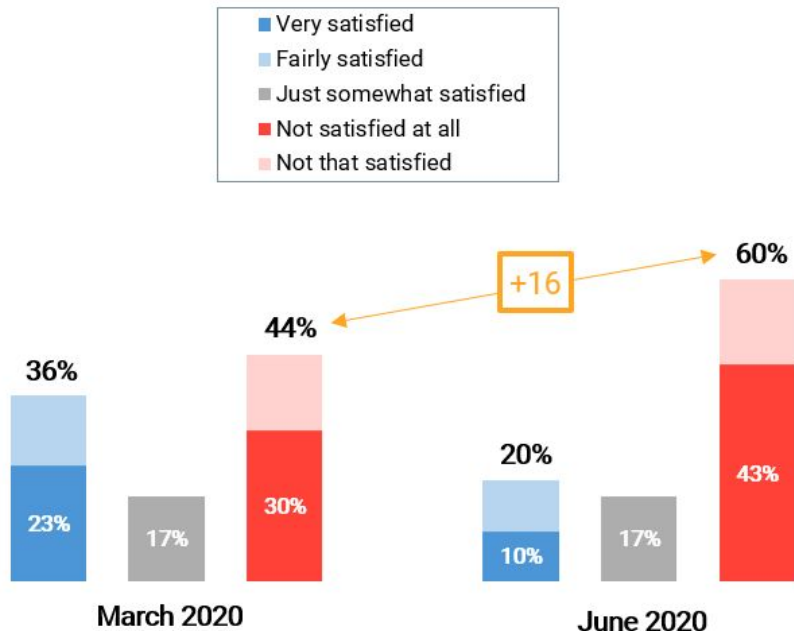

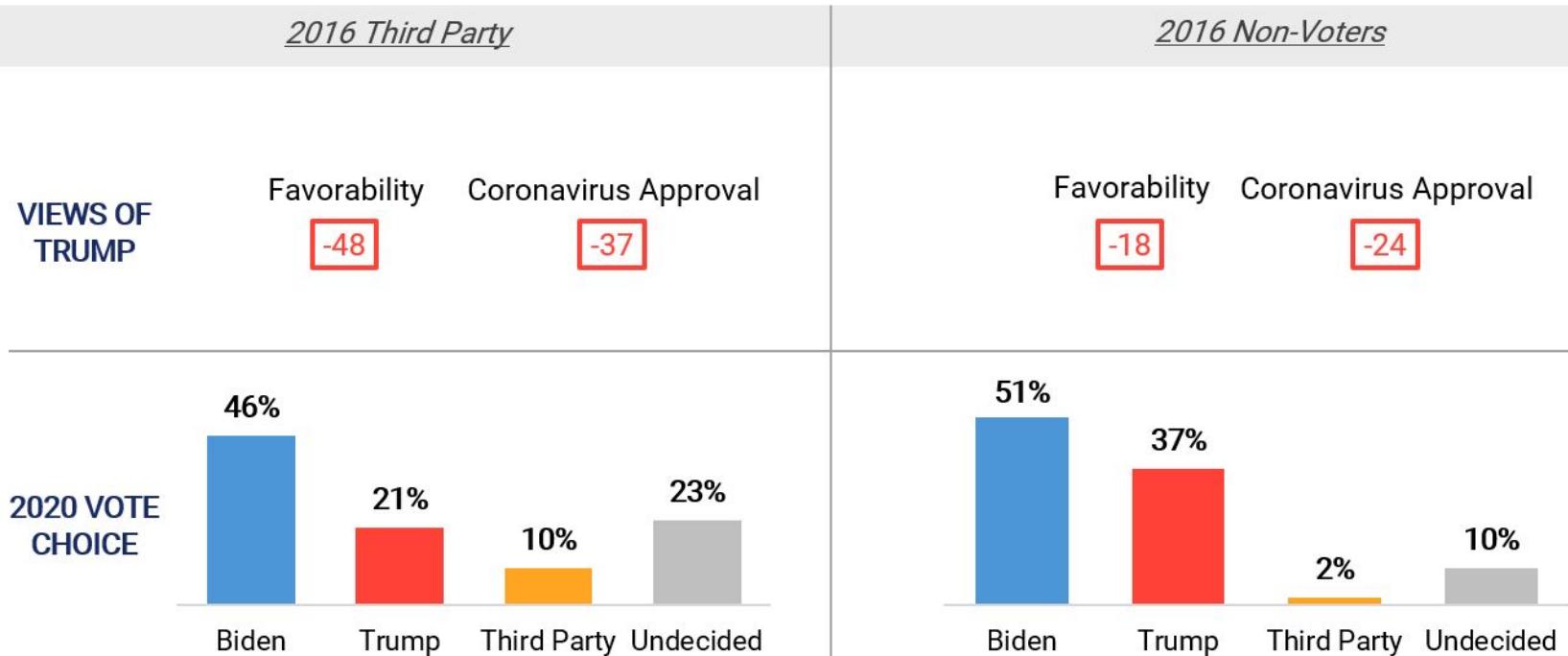

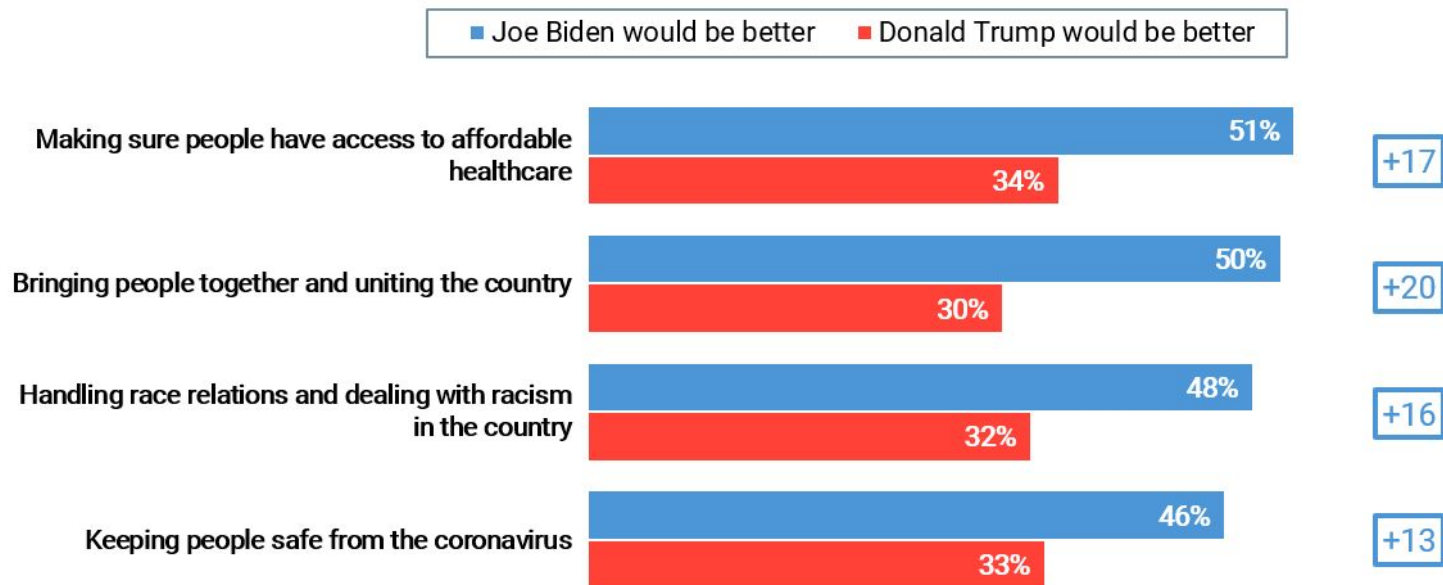

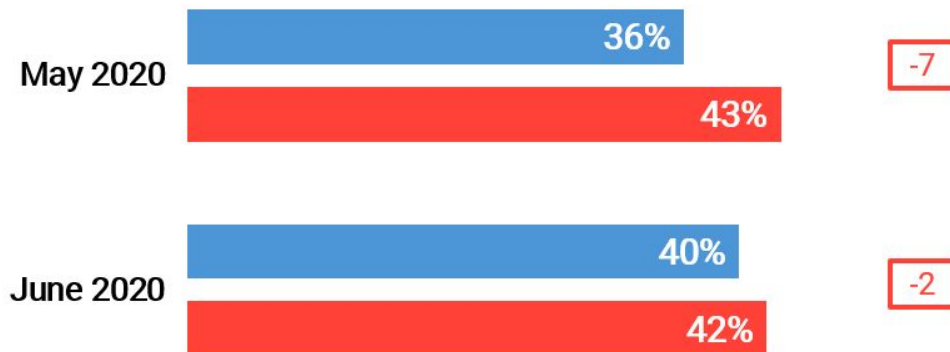

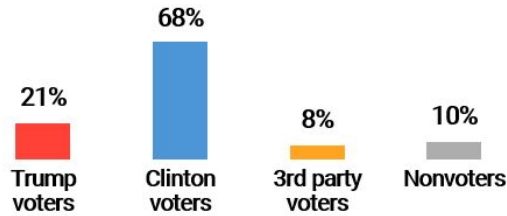
Trump's leadership failures are leading swing voters to bail on Trump and hastening Democratic base consolidation. We have a plan to retain these new voters.



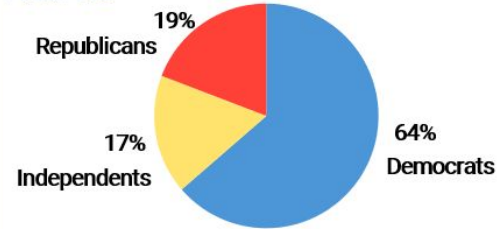

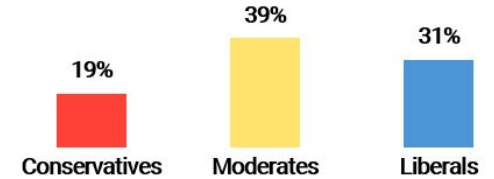

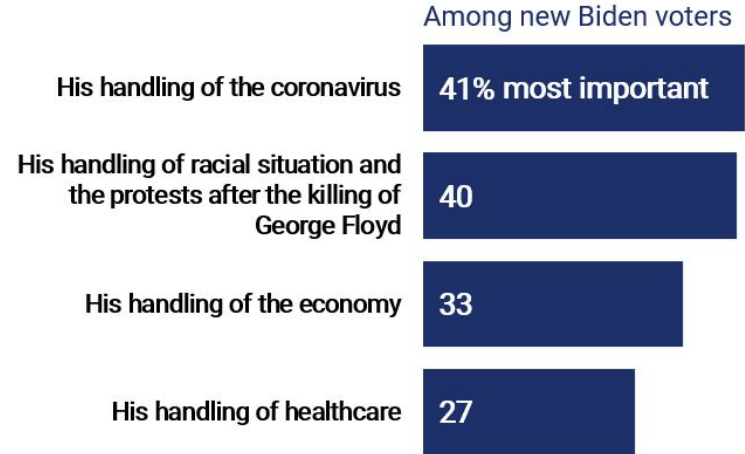

Donald Trump's Approval Among New Biden voters

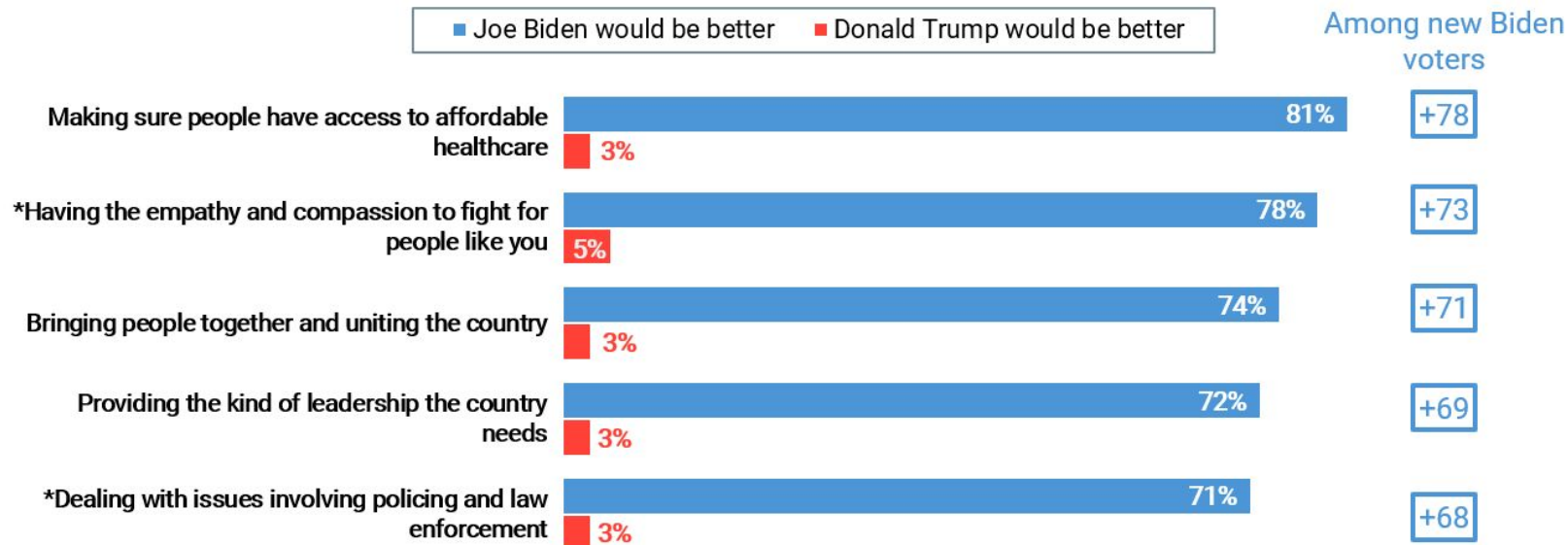


Most important to you in thinking about whether Donald Trump deserves to be reelected? [Top Two]



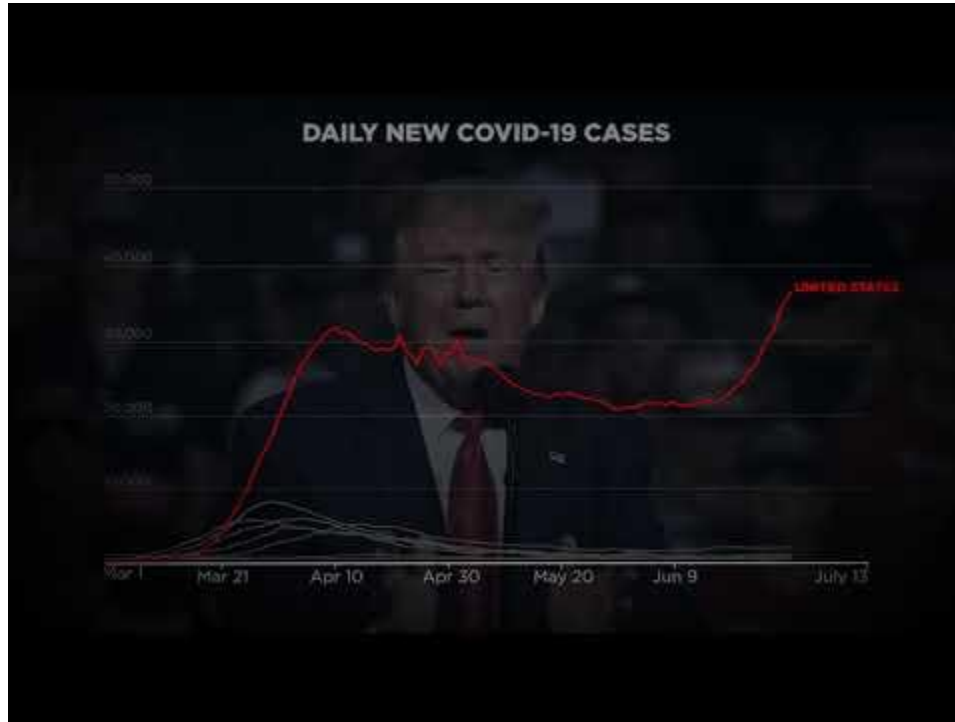

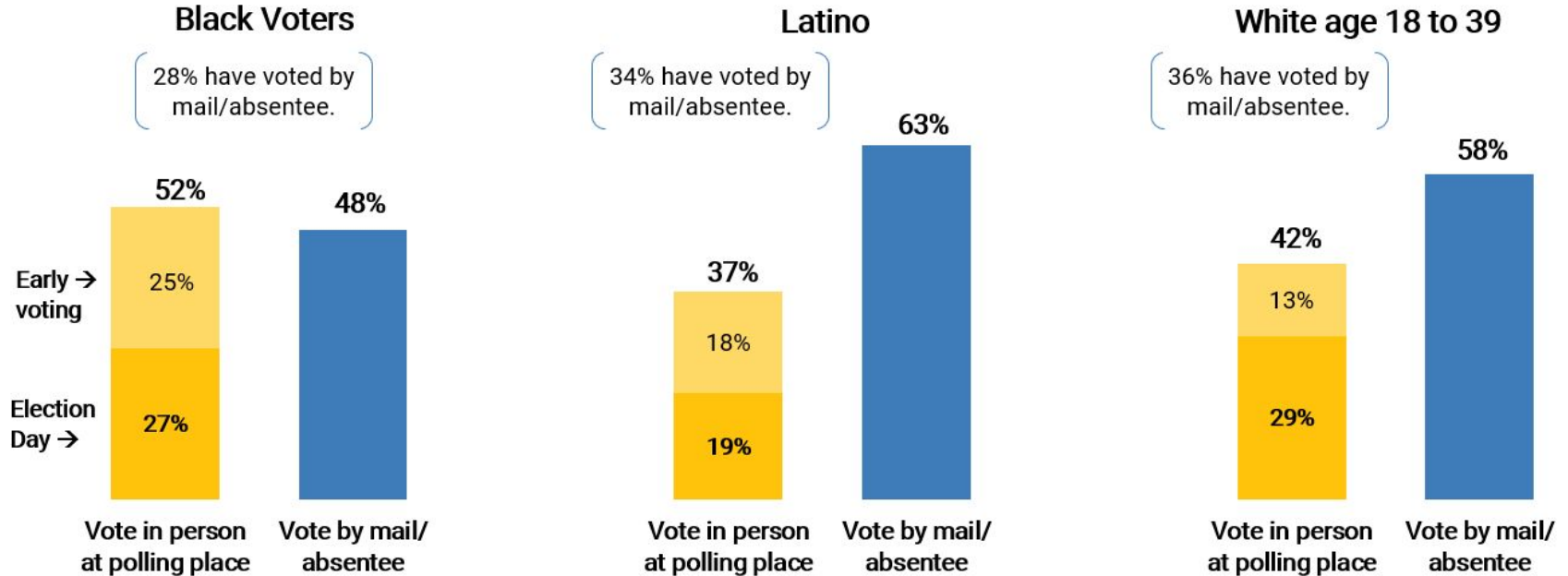

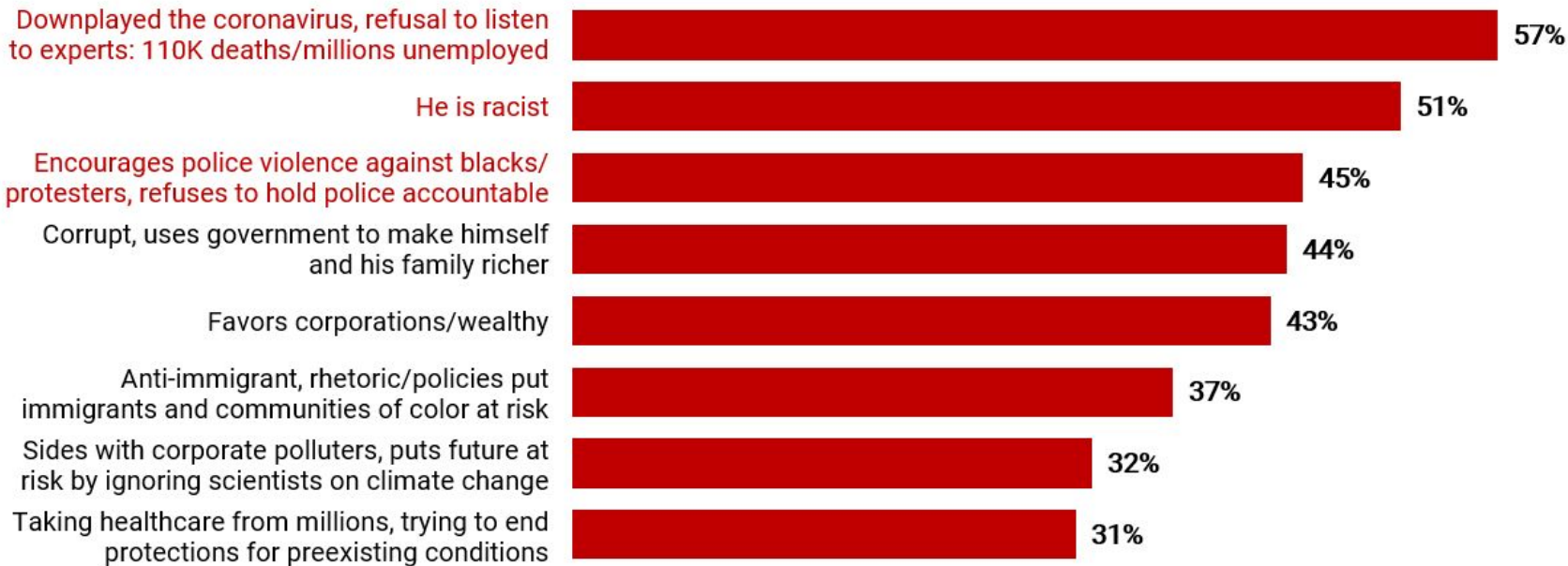
