






#### BIDEN'S PATH TO 270 IS WIDENING










## BIDEN SUPPORTERS MORE MOTIVATED THAN TRUMP SUPPORTERS BY FILLING THE VACANCY






## VOTERS OF COLOR ARE MOST LIKELY TO BE MOBILIZED BY SCOTUS VACANCY





#### YOUNGER VOTERS ALSO MOBILIZED BY SCOTUS VACANCY






### **NEW BATTLEGROUND POLLING**

#### Methodology

#### ONLINE SURVEYS: LIKELY VOTERS

- 2,019 likely voters across six key battleground states: Arizona, Florida, Michigan, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin
- Conducted October 2<sup>nd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- Among those who voted in 2016: 47% Clinton, 49% Trump, 4% third-party candidate (self-report).
- Results weighted in proportion to share of electoral votes per state. Within states, results weighted to demographics of a likely presidential electorate.






As we enter the final weeks of the campaign, Biden is shoring up support as Trump is falling.




#### BIDEN'S FAVORABILITY WITH VOTERS IS SURGING






Proportion saying they are extremely motivated and enthusiastic ("10" out of a 0-10 scale) to vote this election






#### TRUMP IS RUNNING OUT OF TIME TO TURN THINGS AROUND

(Among VBM/early voters) Which of the following best describes the time period which you think you will cast your vote?









Has what you have seen and heard lately about Donald Trump made you feel more favorable or less favorable toward him?













#### OUR DIGITAL PROGRAM INCREASED BIDEN VOTE CHOICE...



The program increased
Biden's statewide margin by **1.25pp** on average between
April and October.



#### ...AND DECREASED TRUMP'S APPROVAL RATING



It also decreased Trump's statewide net-approval by **2.4pp** on average between April and October.
