Duties

The specific duties of the Research Associate include:

- Collaborating with the Priorities USA Digital, Press, and Voting Rights teams on short- and long-term projects to advance the organization's mission
- Contributing to research on the Trump administration, the Republican Congress, and individual candidates on an as-needed basis
- Tracking the progress and potential impacts of major legislation
- Fact-checking and copy-editing Priorities USA materials
- Vetting participants in Priorities USA projects
- Other assignments and tasks as requested

Qualifications

Applicants should possess the following qualities:

- Political and/or campaign experience, preferably in campaign research
- Strong research skills and attention to detail
- Excellent writing, grammar, and proofreading skills, including a sharp eye for typos and factual errors
- Ability to work independently and adhere to tight deadlines
- Ability to keep up with rapid developments in current events and legislation
- Familiarity with LexisNexis, campaign finance filings, and government databases strongly preferred
