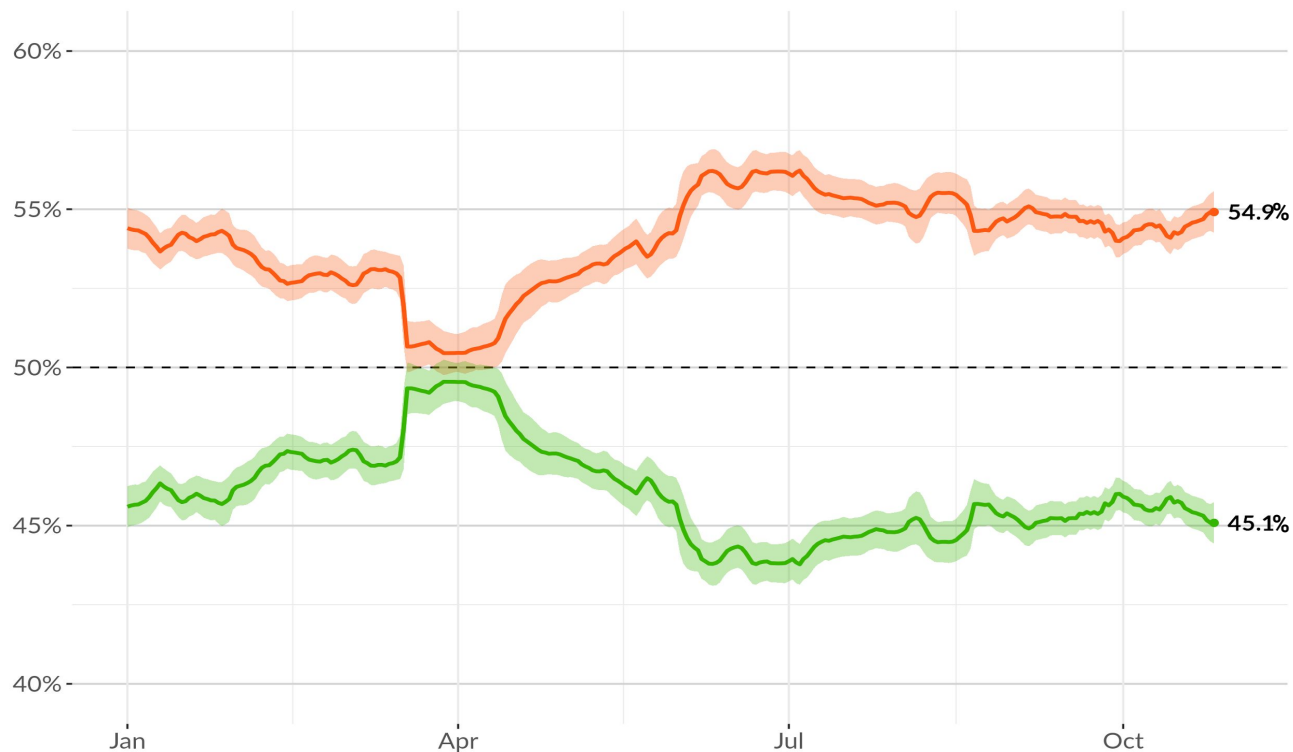

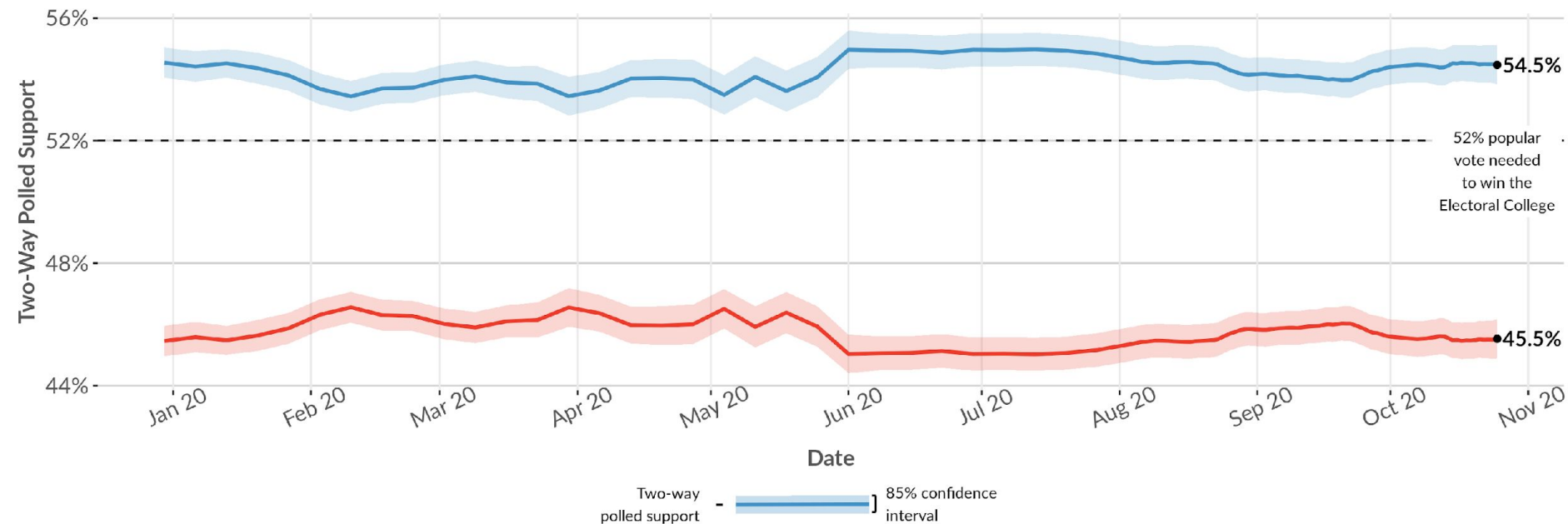

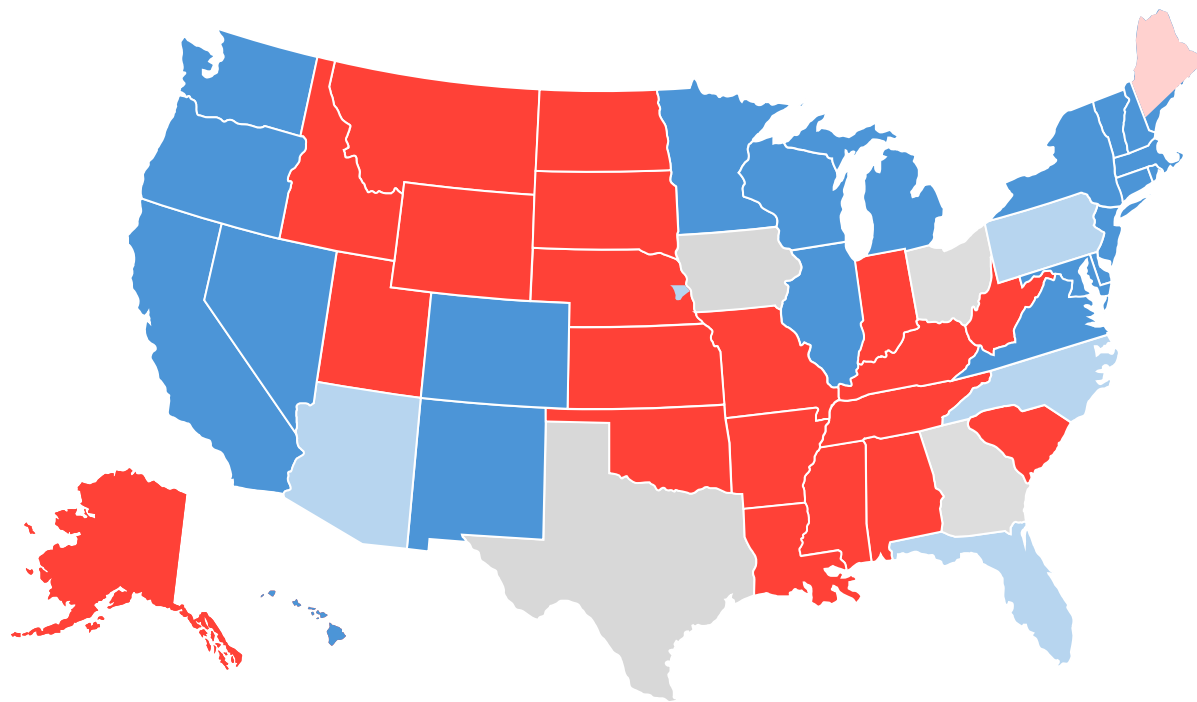
TRUMP APPROVAL HAS DROPPED IN LAST COUPLE WEEKS



THE RACE HAS BEEN RELATIVELY STABLE

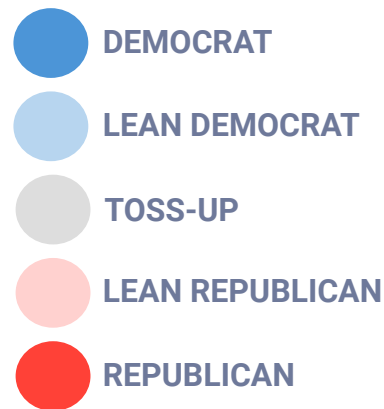


BIDEN HAS MULTIPLE PATHS TO 270

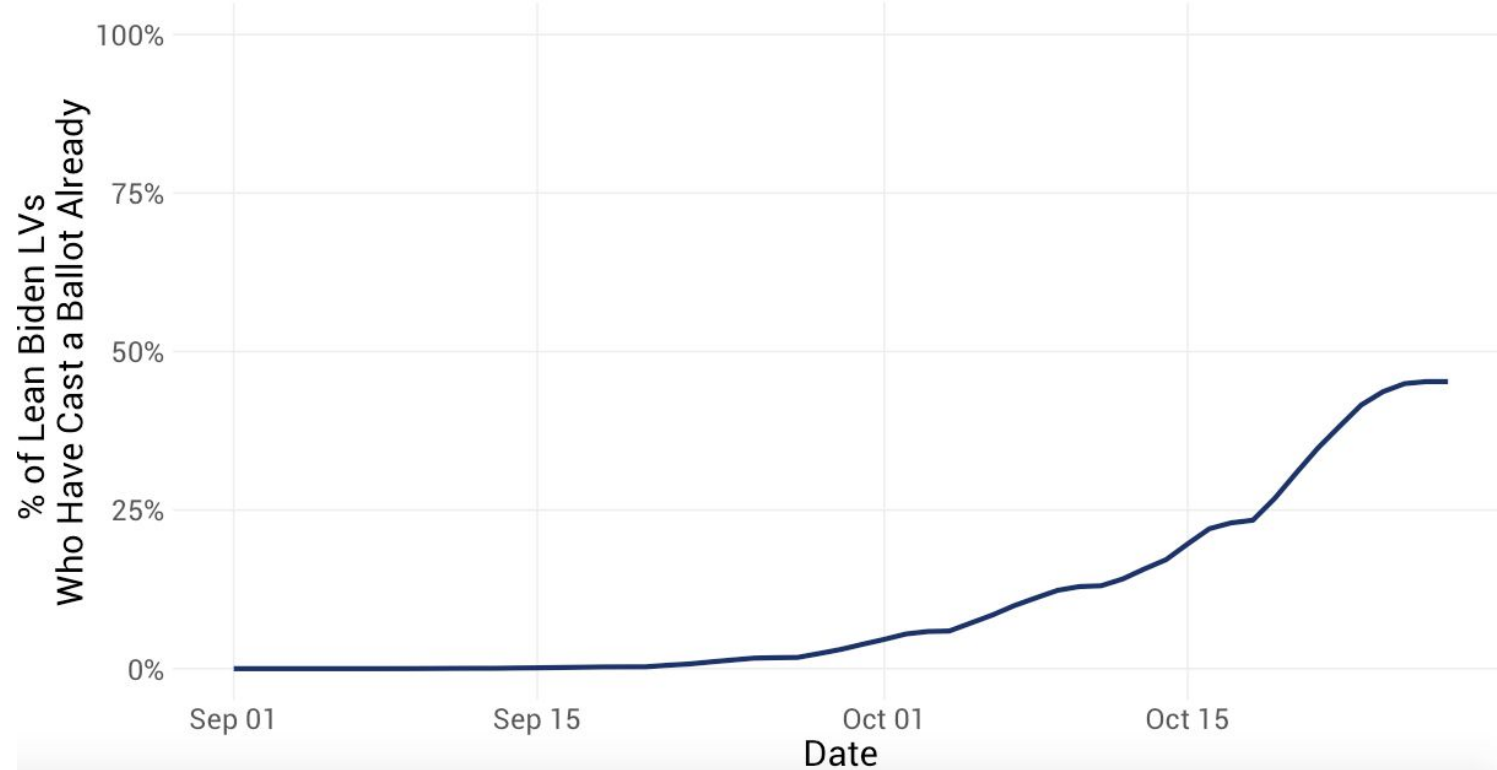

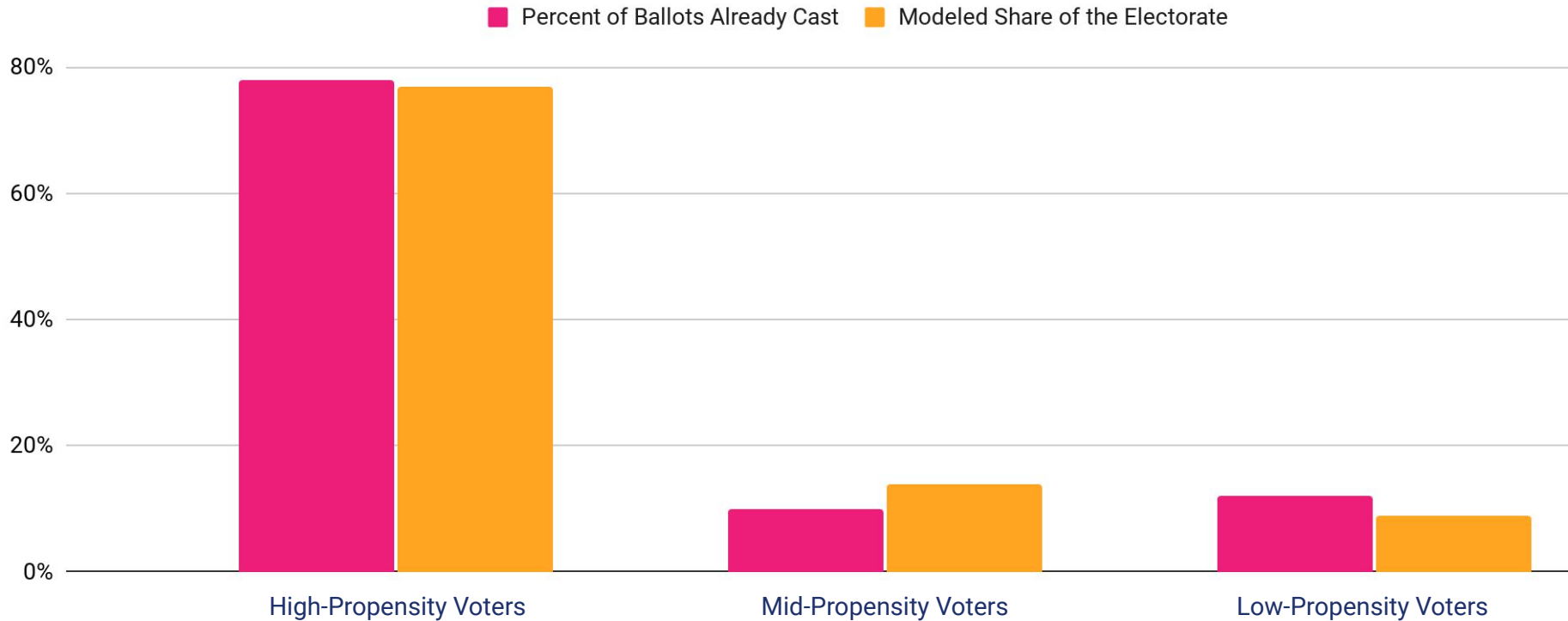

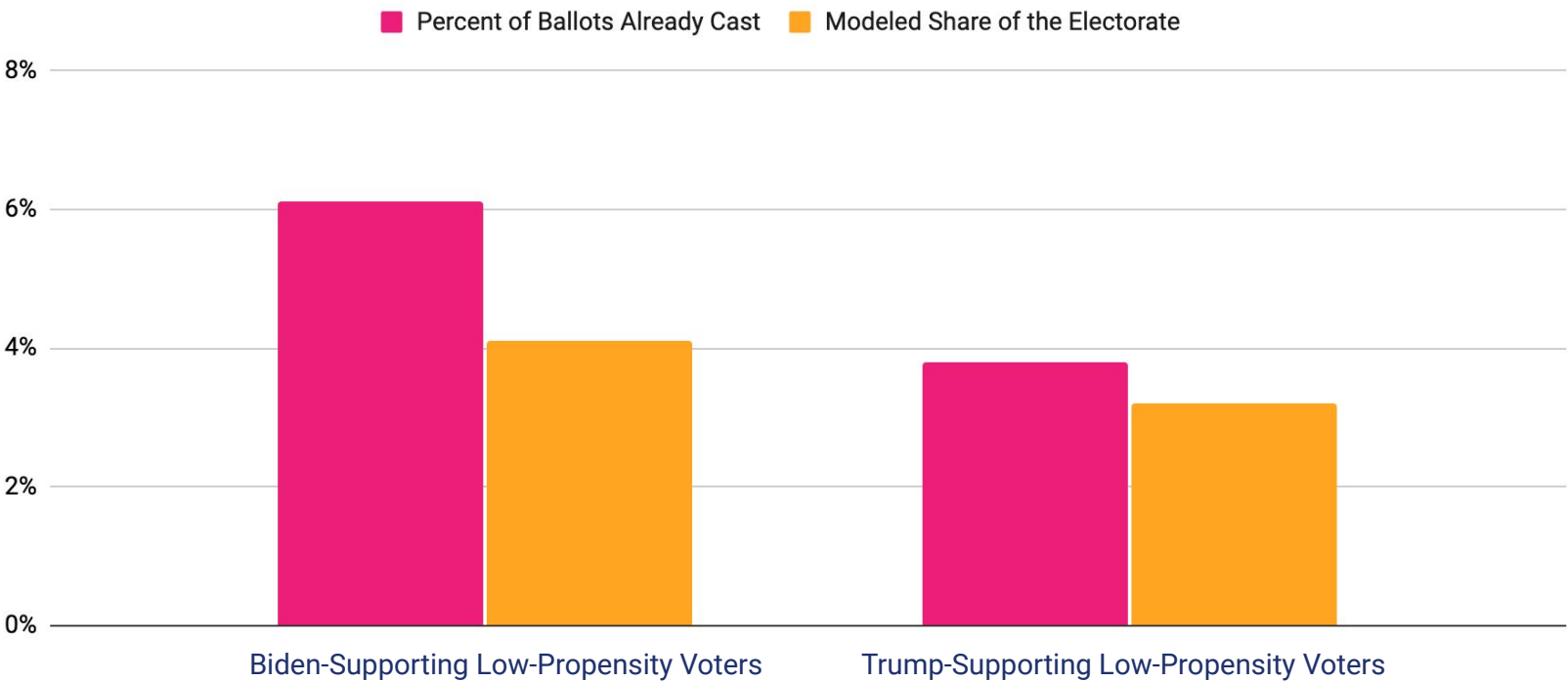
NEARLY HALF OF LEAN-BIDEN VOTERS HAVE ALREADY VOTED

AMONG LOW PROPENSITY INDIVIDUALS, BIDEN IS DOING BETTER

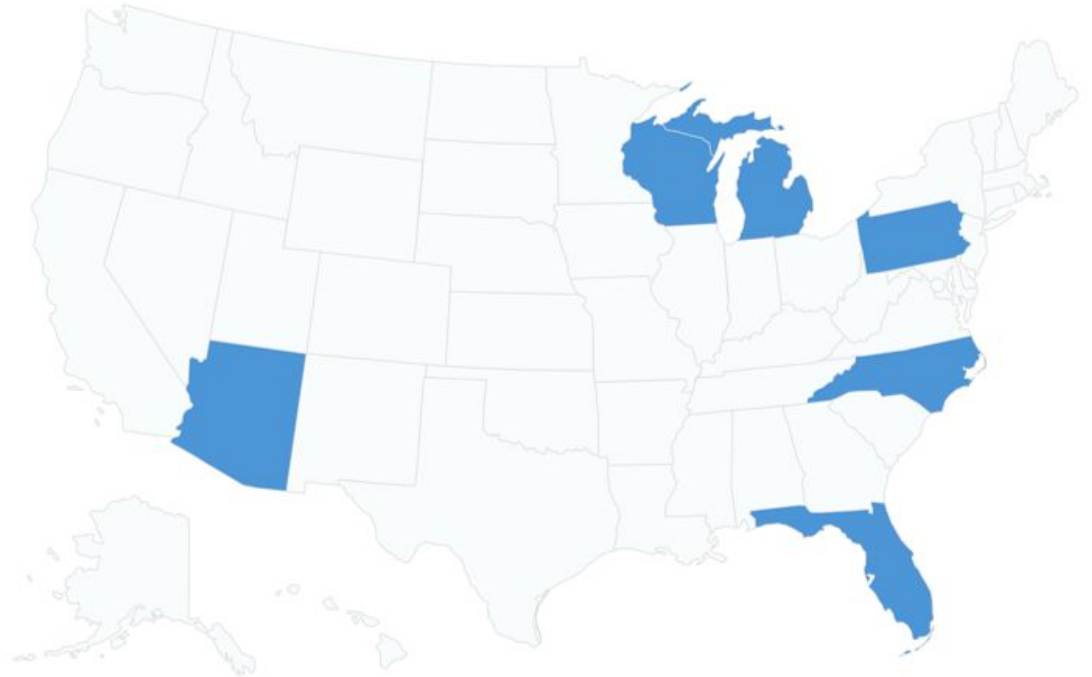

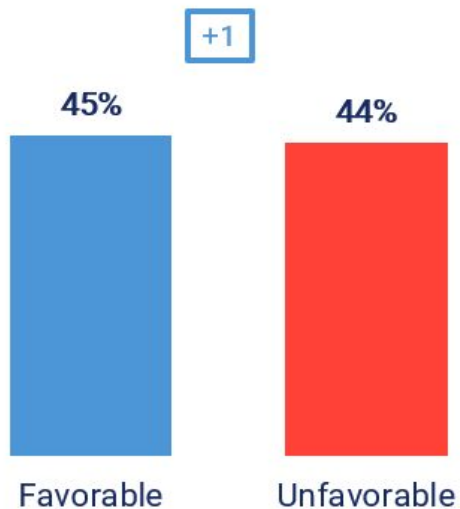

PHONE SURVEYS: LIKELY VOTERS

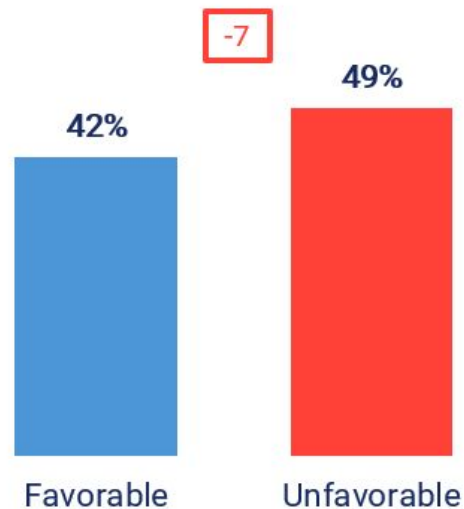

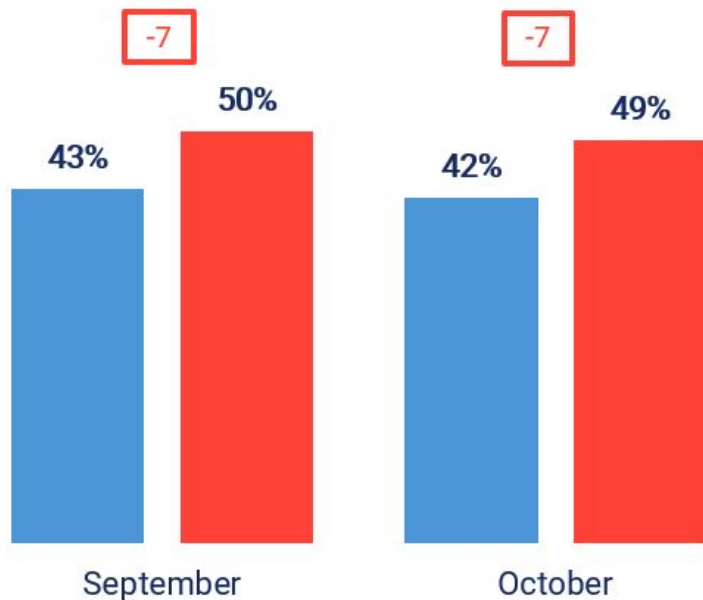

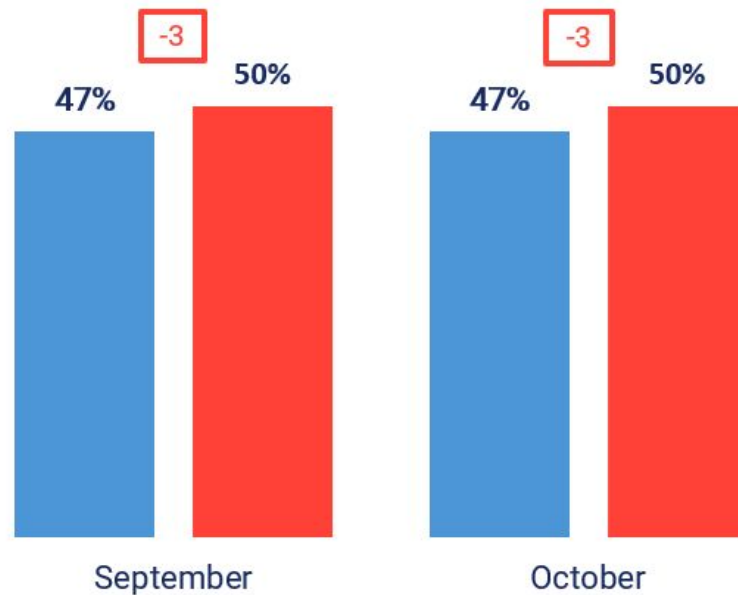

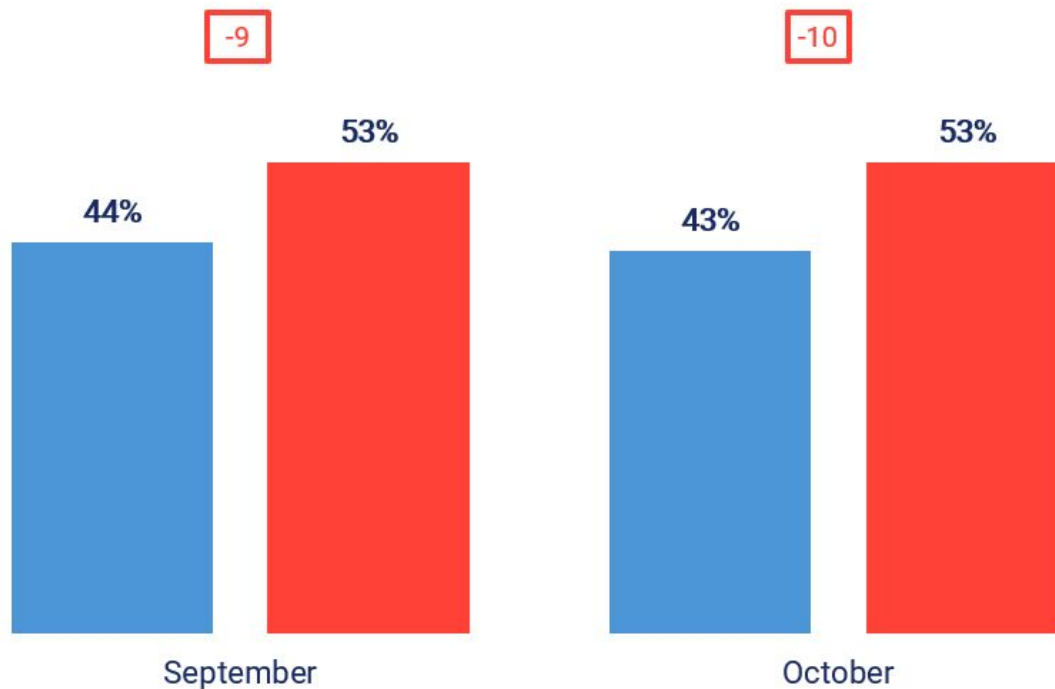
Feelings toward Donald Trump



Donald Trump's Job Approval Overall

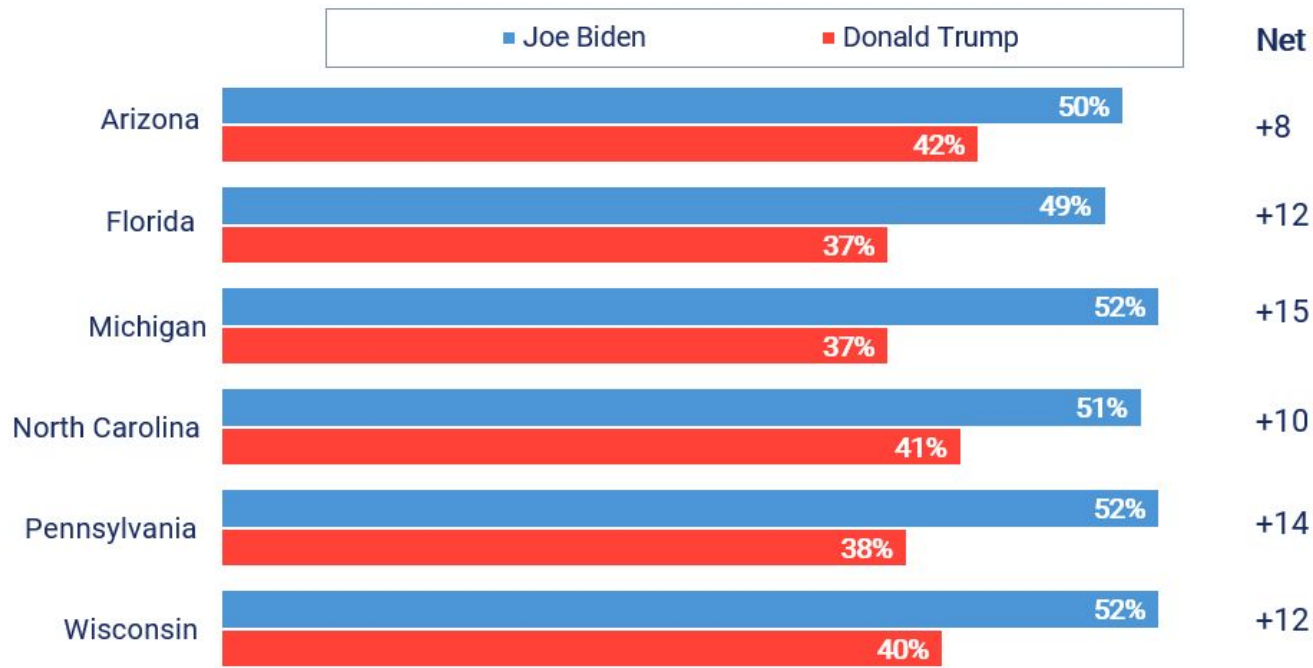

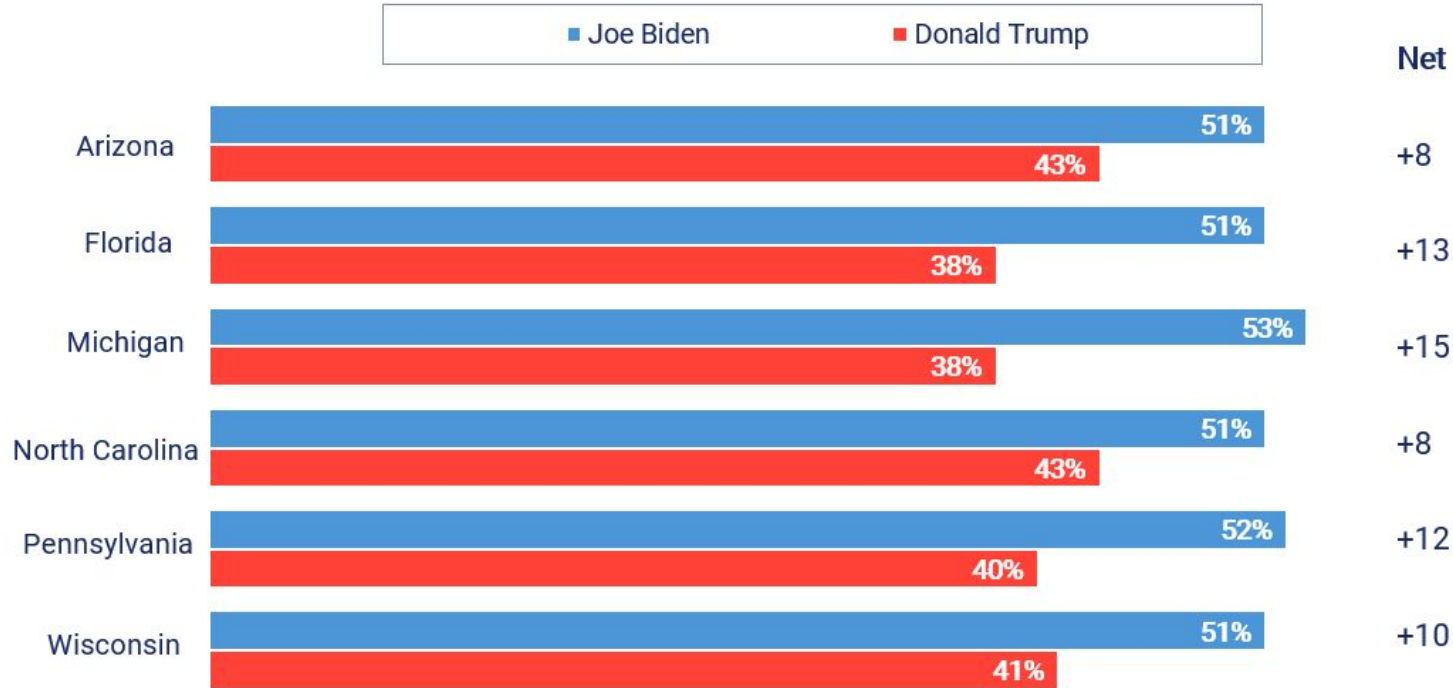

Who do you think would be better in dealing with the coronavirus?



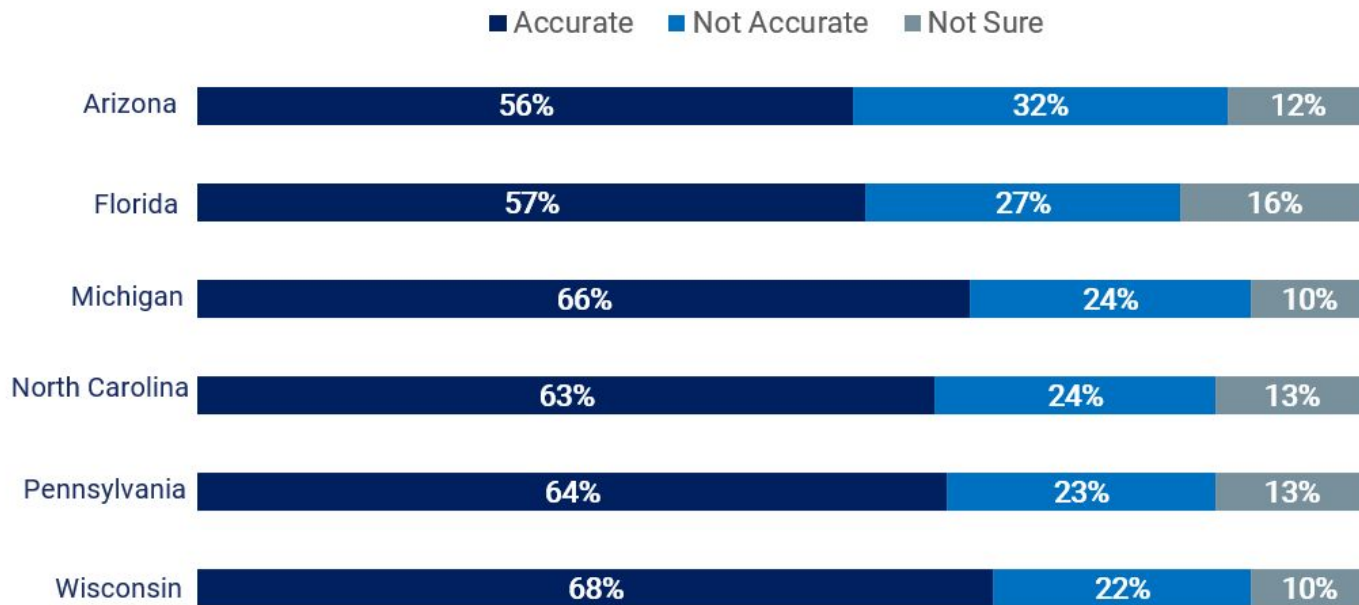

[Among voters who say we are experiencing a new wave] How much responsibility do you think Donald Trump has for the fact the country is experiencing another major wave of coronavirus infections?

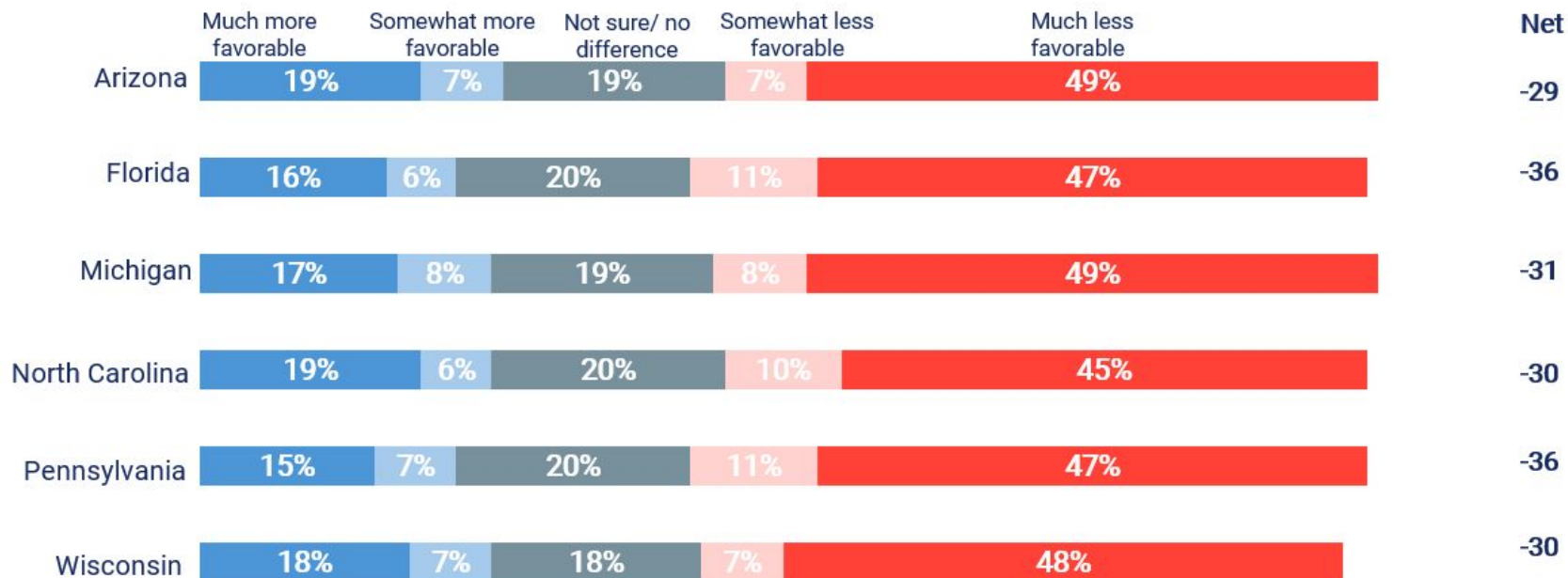

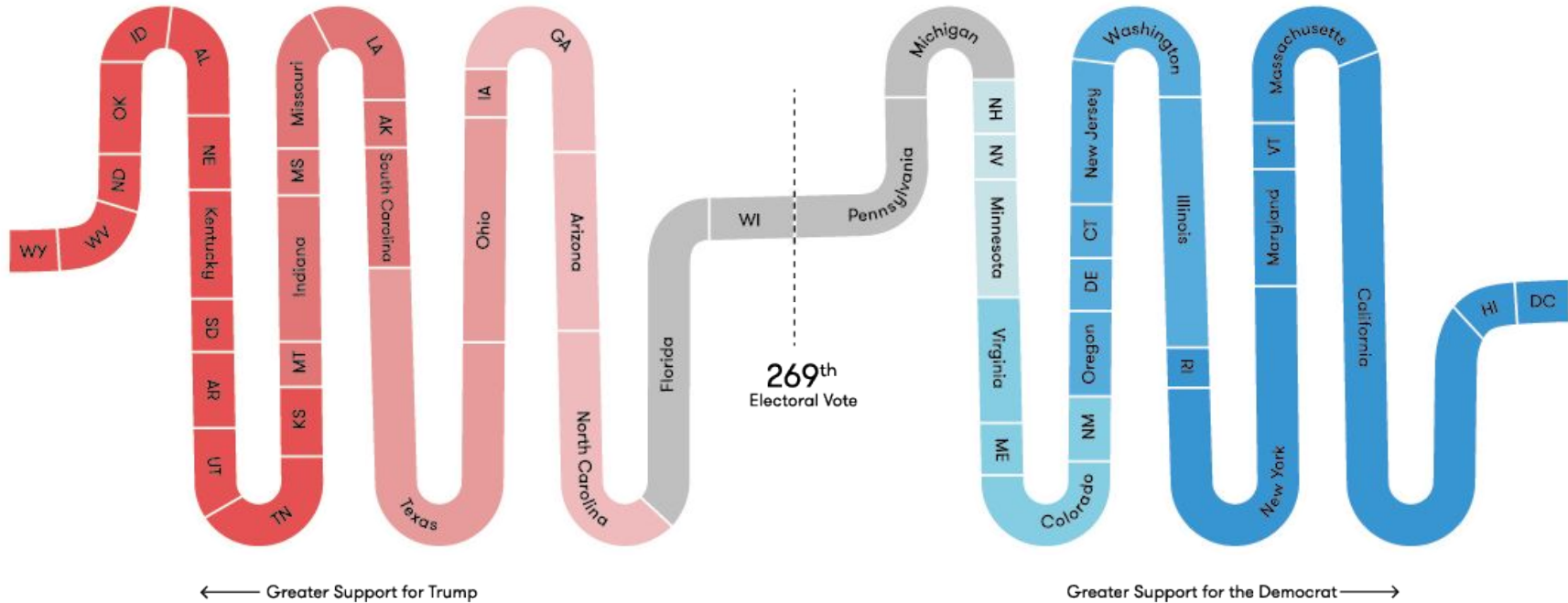
TRUMP'S RALLIES ARE DEEPLY UNPOPULAR

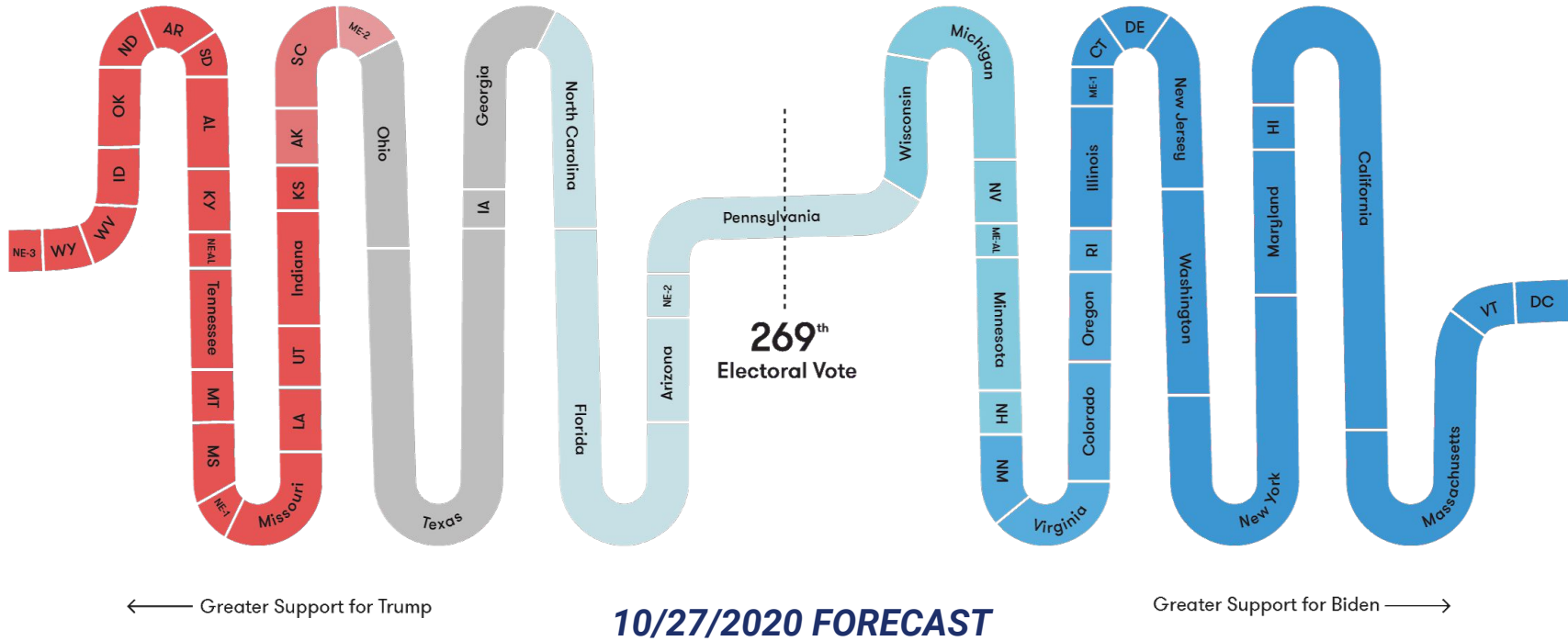

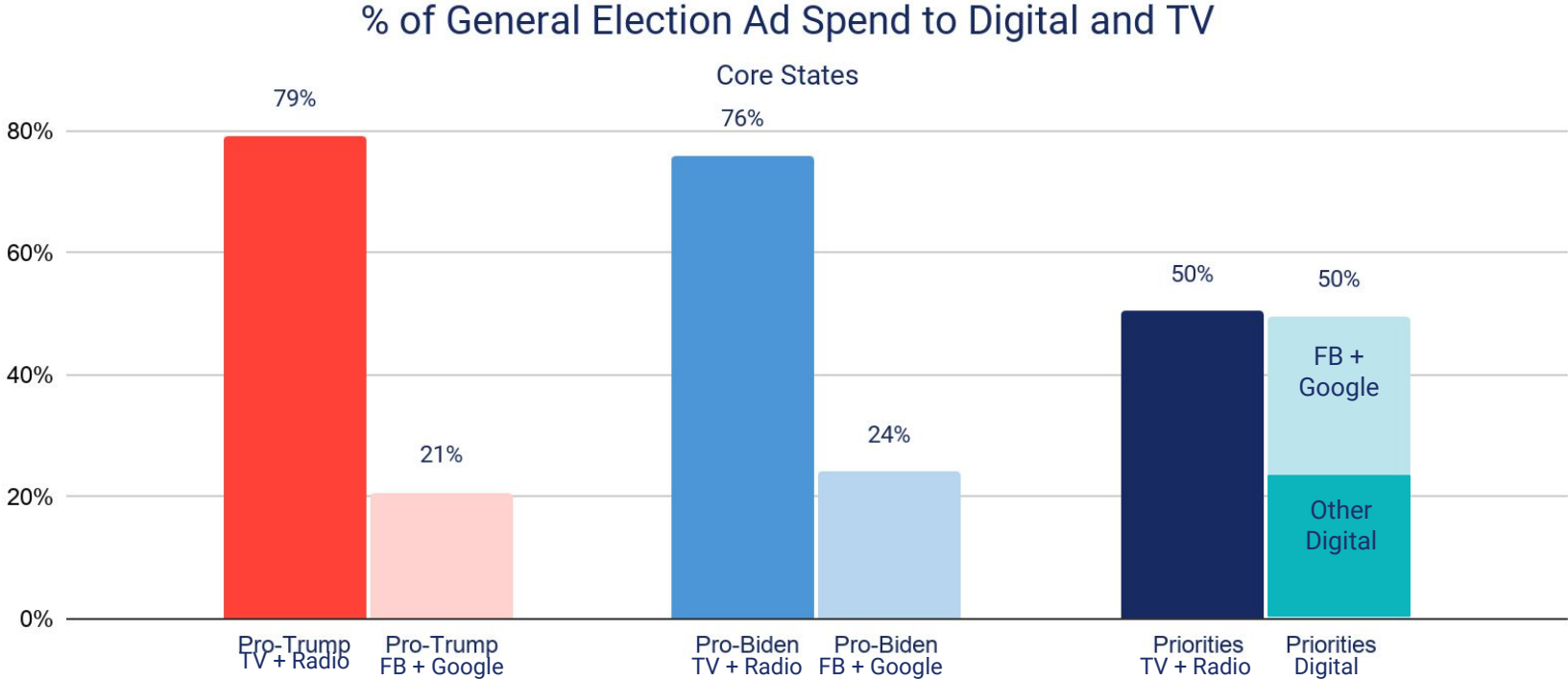

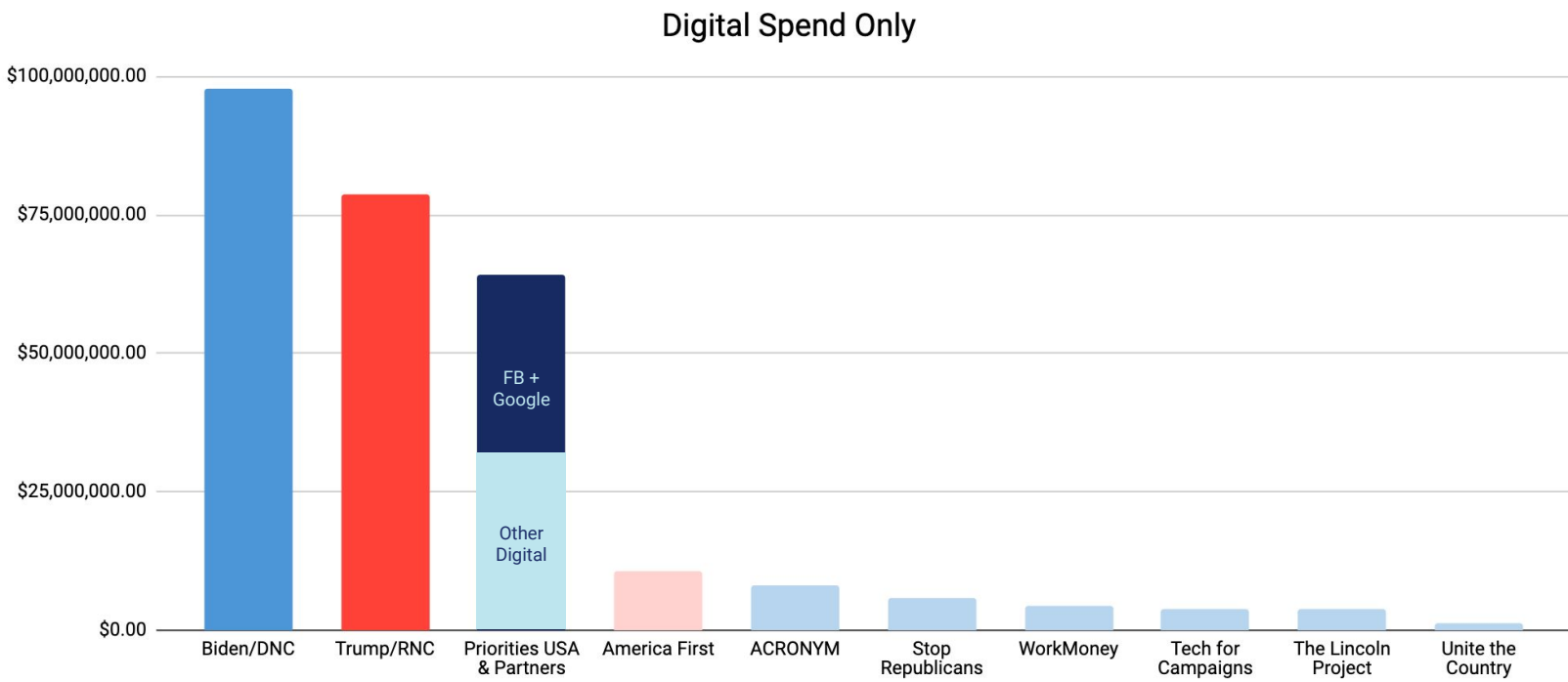

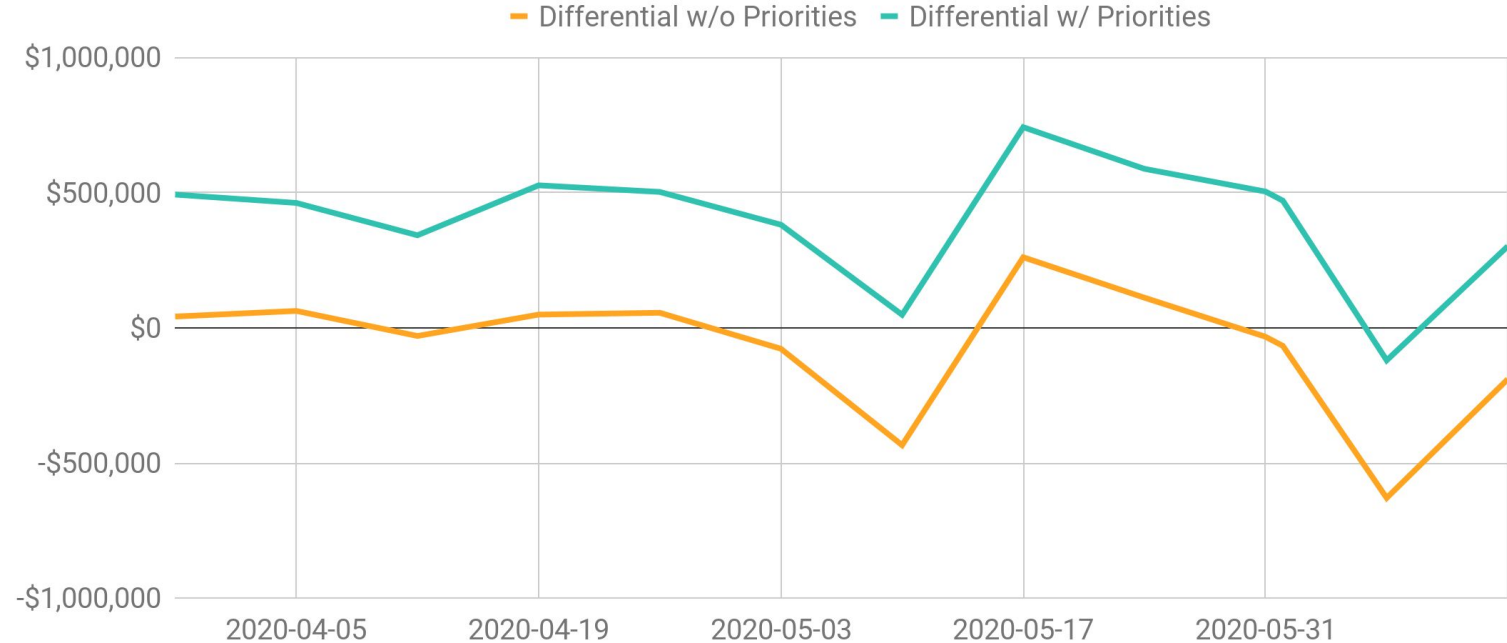
OUR DIGITAL PROGRAMS WERE INSTRUMENTAL IN BIDEN'S LEAD

- Increased Biden's margin by **1.25pp** on average state-wide.

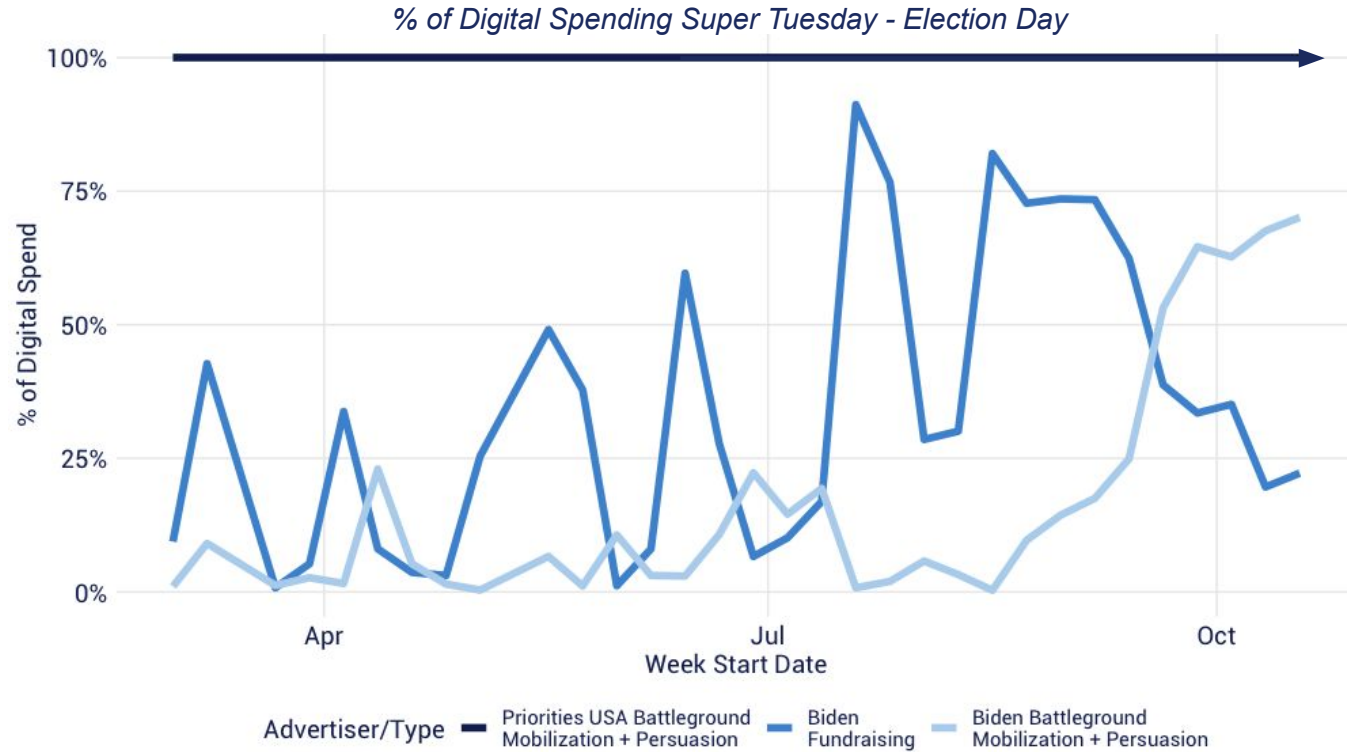
